TECHNICAL SEQUENCES

11-14 Age Group – 33 gymnasts

- Backup rise finishes 45 degrees above horizontal, must show hecht tap
- Toe-on, toe-off finishes 45 degrees above horizontal
- Center of mass above bar height on dismount

15-18 Age Group – 21 gymnasts

- Endo finishes in handstand
- Toe-on, toe-off finishes 45 degrees above horizontal
- Center of mass above bar height on dismount

NOTES

- The most common deductions came from angle deductions (see charts below)
- Most gymnasts who did not receive all elements group credit was due to partial credit for dismounts.
- The second most common missing element group was group II, flights
- While it is not required to enter from a handstand for in-bar elements, angle deductions do apply upon the exit, or finish of an in-bar skill.
- A layaway (beside a back-uprise free hip or stalder) is a .3 deduction

Deviations in Swing To or Through Handstand

* Includes turning skills (i.e. pirouetting skills)

Angular Deviation	Deduction
0° - 15°	No deduction
16° - 30°	-0,1
31° - 45°	-0.3
> 45°	-0.5 & *non-recognition by D-Jury)

Deviations in Turning Elements Finishing in m/g or e/g

* Includes Rybalkos, Higgins, 1/1 turns from u/g

Angular Deviation	Deduction
0° - 30°	No deduction
31° 45°	-0.1
46° 90°	-0.3
> 90°	-0.5 *non-recognition by D-Jury
